## Travelling to Diamond

Diamond is part of the Rutherford Appleton Laboratory (RAL) site within Harwell Campus. The campus has excellent bus, rail, bike and road connections. Parking on Harwell Campus is limited and cannot be guaranteed. We recommend travelling by public transport.

If you are driving to site and wish to park around the synchrotron building, you will need to request a parking permit when you initially register at the RAL Reception.

## Accessing the site

Go to the RAL Main Gate (building R75) and register at RAL Reception. To access the site, government-issued ID, such as a passport or driving licence, is required.
