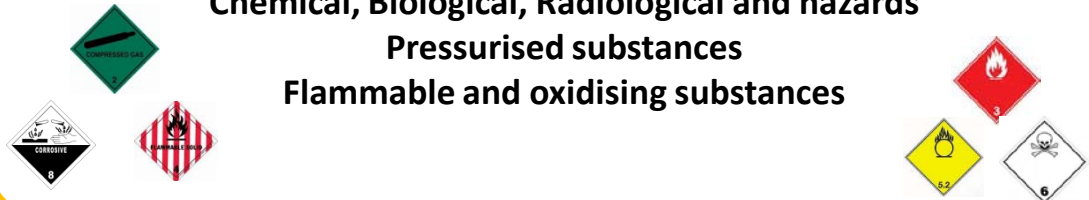




Diamond User Code 4: Sample Transport



Hazards



Chemical, Biological, Radiological and hazards
Pressurised substances
Flammable and oxidising substances

Risks

Release of hazardous substances during private transport.
No specialist response capability
No compliance with UK law on hazardous good transport

Controls

Users are encouraged to use a suitable courier for the transport and delivery of dangerous goods to and from Diamond.

If transporting samples to and from Diamond, users must ensure the following:

- The samples are packaged in accordance with CDG
- The amount of substance does not exceed the limits set out in ADR
- The correct hazard placards are displayed
- The vehicle is suitable for the task
- The correct emergency equipment is carried
- The correct sample information is carried
